Looking back to the first half of the 2019/20 season, our U13, U16 and adult teams played again an important role at the Belgian floorball scene. As you know, our teams have players from different countries and are subject to a higher fluctuation of players. Nonetheless, our teams showed stable performance again.

In September, we were happy to play a friendly match at Place Schuman under the auspices of the Finnish Presidency of the EU. We hosted U13 competition games in November 2019 and planned to support Special Olympics in May 2020, which was cancelled, as was the case with all other sport activities.
